WHY PLASTICS?

Since its appearance on the scene of the materials, back in 1860 with the production of celluloid or by 1909 with the development of Bakelite, plastics have been gaining ground day by day and throughout the years they were replacing other materials in their applications, such as metals, wood or glass.

What are some of the benefits that have plastic?

- Plastics are chemically inert; it offers full safety for use in packaging food, medicines, beverages and any product intended for human or animal consumption.
- Plastics require less energy to produce than other materials, which contributes to reduced energy use and lower production costs.
- Being lighter, require less fuel consumption during transportation and subsequent to its use, a reduction in the weight of trash.
- Once converted into waste, plastics can be reused through recycling or energy generation through incineration.
- Used in packaging, being transparent allow the consumer to see the packaged product, color, freshness and composition.
- Plastic containers offer high strength and are almost unbreakable, which prevents the contents from spilling or damage generated in the packaged product.
- They can be processed for manufacture through a variety of methods of production, from mechanizing machine tools to 3D printing or from injection to blowing.
- They are highly efficient since a small amount of material can be used for packing large amounts of products.
- They are good electrical and acoustic insulates, allowing use where protection against electrical hazards or noise insulation is required.
